RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Move and deliver equipment to and from construction sites, utilizing a lowbed trailer with Jeep and booster or tilt deck recovery trailer
- Load and unload vehicles and equipment such as loaders, bobcat, tandem gravel trucks with pup, sand/plow trucks and triaxle side dump.
- Deliver and operate equipment during summer and winter conditions on forestry, and off-road sites and terrain
- Transport aggregate materials on occasion with end dump or tandem truck and pup
- Perform pre-trip inspection and complete necessary paperwork, including accurate logbooks, inspection logbook and records of cargo
- Comply with provincial driving rules and regulations (hours of service, trips inspections, cargo securement, size, weight, route designations, wrapping stations, parking, and break periods) as well as with company policies and procedures
- Inspect equipment for mechanical items and safety issues and notify supervisor of defects or mechanical issues
- Adhere to workplace safety policies, regulations and compliances
